## Chesapeake Figure Skating Club Skaters Code of Conduct

---

The following is a **Code of Conduct** for all Chesapeake Figure Skating Club (CFSC) members to abide by both on and off the ice as well as at competitions and test sessions to ensure the enjoyment, safety and development of all skaters.

### SKATERS AND PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

1. All skaters and parents are to show good sportsmanship, treat other skaters, coaches, parents and volunteers with respect on and off the ice.
2. Skaters or parents using profanity and disrespectful behavior to other members, parents or coaches will be subject to disciplinary actions.
3. Skaters must dress appropriately when representing CFSC while at the rink, during competitions and test sessions.
4. Do not take part in gossip, discuss other skaters or spread rumors. Follow the 3 R's: Respect for self, Respect for others and Responsibility for all actions.

### SKATERS ON ICE CODE OF CONDUCT

#### Right of Way

5. Always attempt to give right of way to a skater in a lesson or whose music is being played.
6. Skaters must show consideration for coaches and other skaters involved in lessons during sessions.

#### Use of Ice

7. When working or standing on the side, please check prior to entering the flow of skaters to make sure you are not interfering or cutting in front of another skater.
8. Always pay attention to the position of all skaters especially reverse jumpers.
9. When skating backwards, always look in the direction of travel.
10. Avoid skating or standing in the corners of the rink for extended periods of time. Corners are used for jumping and this can be especially dangerous for those skaters jumping reverse.
11. Sitting, kneeling or laying on the ice is not permitted. After falling please get up as soon as possible and out of the way of other skaters. If injured, please alert another skater or coach for help.
12. Standing and talking with other skaters must be done off-ice.

#### Music Policy

13. Skaters in a lesson have priority with music. Skaters not in a lesson may stack their music on or next to the CD player and wait their turn.

**Skaters who observe unsafe, rude or inconsiderate behavior on the part of other skaters should report this at once to the figure skating director or any CFSC Board Member.**

# Chesapeake Figure Skating Club Code of Conduct



## **I. Mission Statement:**

Chesapeake Figure Skating club believes that figure skating, testing, competitions and rink behavior should demonstrate the highest standards of ethics, sportsmanship and character. Skaters will be expected to be committed to respect, responsibility and fairness. This Code of Conduct shall apply to all skaters, coaches and parents involved in this club.

## **II. Purpose:**

The purpose of Chesapeake Figure Skating Club Code of Conduct is to set forth clear and consistent behavioral expectations for its members and their families and to inform the consequences that will occur for rule violations.

## **III. Behavioral Expectations:**

Chesapeake Figure Skating Club members are expected to act in a manner that represents the members, fellow skaters, the club and community in a positive manner. Conduct unbecoming of a member or parent will not be tolerated, and any violation of the Code of Conduct may result in verbal warning, written warning, suspension or termination from the club. The severity or frequency of the infraction will determine the extent of the consequences.

Parents/Guardians are expected to be familiar with and adhere to CFSC's Code of Conduct. Parents/Guardians should also be courteous to other parents, skaters, coaches, judges and visitors at all times. Positive communication with other parents and coaches is encouraged.

## **IV. Infractions and Disciplinary Actions**

The Chesapeake Figure Skating Club (CFSC) Code of Conduct is intended to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for all of its members. Violations of the Code of Conduct will subject the member to disciplinary action by the CFSC Board. Any skater who is on suspension from CFSC will not be allowed to participate in any Club activity, nor will the skater be able to represent CFSC at competitions. The CFSC Board has the final authority of all disciplinary matters. Violations will be handled as follows:

**1<sup>st</sup> Offense** – Verbal Warning

**2<sup>nd</sup> Offense** – Written Warning

**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense** – Suspension of Club privileges and/or termination of Club Membership.\*

\* Requires meeting of all concerned parties, including skater, parent/guardian (if skater is under 18) and Board Members. Coaches may also attend. Length of suspension will be determined based on the seriousness and type of offense and its' severity.

Reporting of any incident by Club members must be submitted in writing with signature to any CFSC Board Member within 24 hours of the incident.
